- Our **Under 5'S** Group runs on Mondays 09:30 to 11:30. Please contact Sergio&Cheri for more Information. (Term time only)

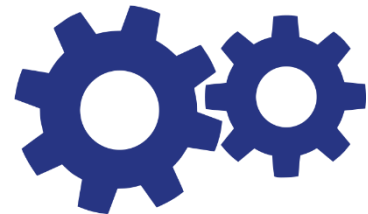

3 September: In Christ Alone (1 Timothy 2:1-7)

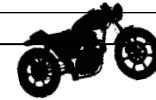
10 September: By Scripture Alone (2 Timothy 3:10-17)
